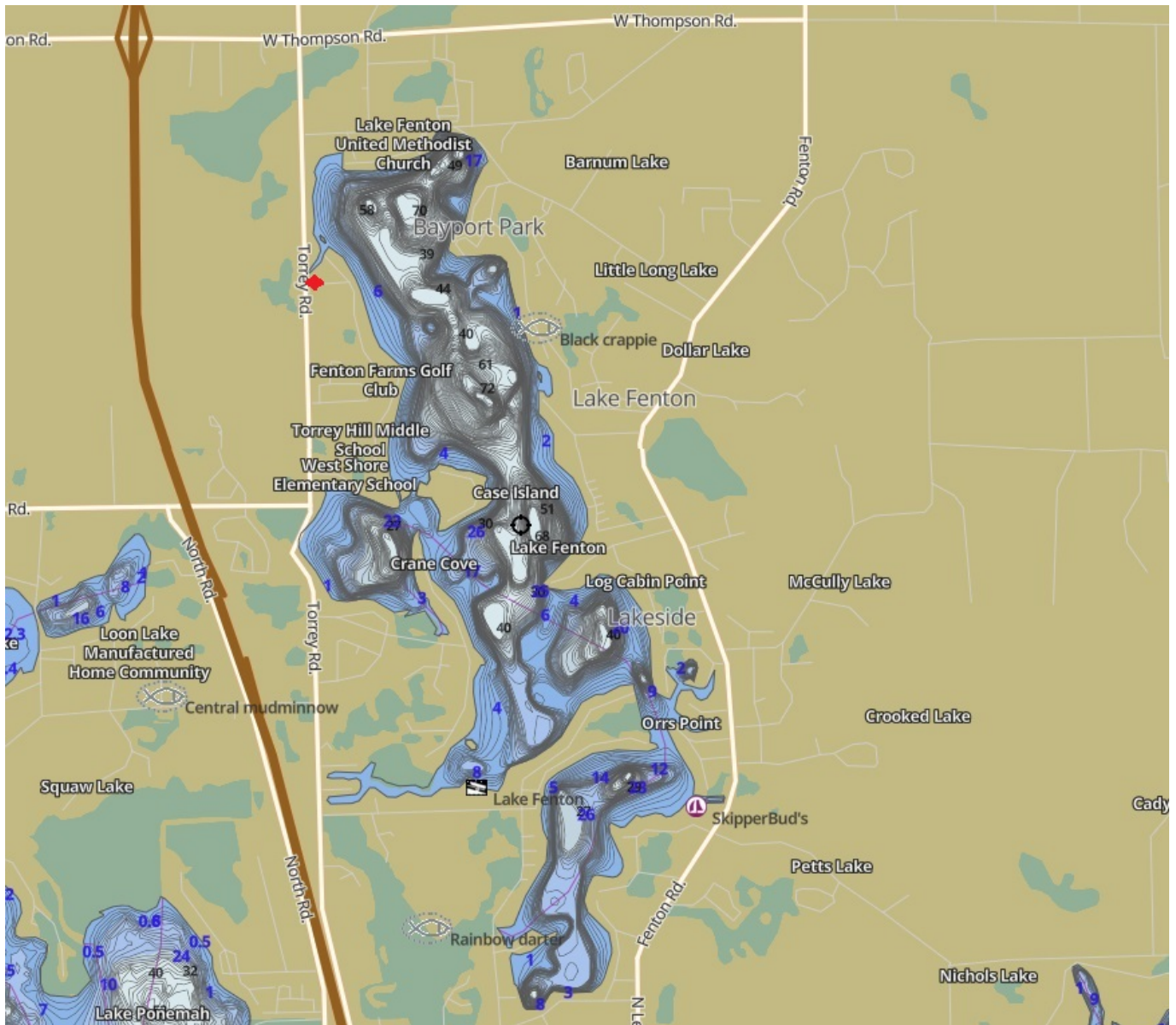


# 12147 Torrey Road- Lake Fenton Info



LAKE FENTON is located in Fenton in southern Genesee County, MI. It is a state-owned natural spring-fed lake spanning an impressive 845 acres. It is affectionately known as the crown jewel of the lakes in Genesee County due to the size, the array of homes, mixing new builds amidst quaint cottages. Lake Fenton's maximum depth is 90 ft. Boaters may launch their watercraft at the DNR site off Grove Park Road. Home to the Moose Lodge, the Polar Plunge, where all the proceeds go to the Special Olympics, the sailing club, hot air balloon landings, and wildlife galore, the Venetian Nights Festival, Lake Fenton offers something for everyone! The sheer size of the lake makes it perfect for tubing, skiing, swimming, kayaking, fishing, or simply puttering around the lake. Anglers can expect an impressive population of largemouth bass, rock bass, smallmouth bass, panfish, black crappie, bluegill, northern pike, walleye, sunfish, and yellow perch fishing on Lake Fenton.
